## 1. Enrollment Preparation for Winter Screening

- Winter screeners will are now available to use.
- To assign a winter screener, subscribe to the winter program under AVAILABLE PROGRAMS. Then, select the program to display each screener within the selected program.
- For additional support to prepare for winter screening, click on the guide or video.

## 2. New Kindergarten and Geometry Readiness Screeners

- Kindergarten readiness standards are aligned to <u>Greer Erickson's counting routine</u> referenced in Oakland Schools' <u>Essential Elements Math Emergent & Conventional Flow Chart.</u>
- The kindergarten readiness screener is designed as a one-on-one interview. Educators can record student responses directly into the student's online screener, or they can record student responses on paper to transfer into the online screener at a later time.
- 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> Grade, and High School Geometry readiness standards are end-of-year benchmarks selected from geometry and measurement standards.
- Fall and winter readiness screeners are scheduled to be available on November 6, 2023.
- During the 2023-24 school year, growth charts and quick checks are scheduled for development to frequently monitor progress. Then, visual guided practice will be developed to support the completion of unfinished learning.

## 3. Kids Back on Track Program

- The Delta Math Rtl Program is an approved strategy in the MI Strategy Bank.
