1. Tier 1 Identification and Support

- As the need for tier 2 math support decreases, your team can transition to providing tier 1 support using data from the winter readiness screener for the next grade level.
- Tier 1 support can be provided using targeted practice on the Tier 2 Intervention tab.
- Visual Guided Practice, Visual Fluency Cards, Virtual Card Sorts, Online Practice, and Independent Practice
 may provide the extra focus and spaced-practice that can help students deepen conceptual understanding
 and increase their procedural fluency. (Click for the description of each resource.)
- While students complete their learning with spaced practice, please consider using quick checks and growth charts to monitor their progress and set personal goals.

2. Intervention Group Report Recommendation

- The Intervention Group report displays each student that demonstrated unfinished learning for each readiness standard. When this report is printed, action plans can be created and written directly on this report indicating what, when, and how each student will receive additional support.
- Targeted support can be provided during warm-ups, centers/work-stations, cool-downs, or any classroom transition time.

3. New practice problems for measuring proficiency with math facts

- Online practice problems are now available, in addition to the practice screener, for young students to become familiar with completing the math facts problems online.
- These practice screeners are called: Fluency practice problems: (Add/Sub Numbers to 5), (Add/Sub Numbers to 10), (Add/Sub Numbers to 20), (Multiply/Divide Numbers to 10).
- To assign practice problems and make them available, follow the steps outlined below.
 - o Click on the **Active Course** you would like to practice.
 - SUBSCRIBE the active courses to Delta Math Practice under the AVAILABLE PROGRAMS.
 - Use the drop down for Select Program to choose Delta Math Practice.
 - O Click **Assign & View**, then click to make it **Available**.

4. Updates to the Screening and Reporting Website

- The OAISD Application Development Team is currently updating the screening and reporting website.
- The most recent update changed the color scheme and formatting to resemble the OAISD and the Delta Math implementation support websites.
- More updates are scheduled to occur over the next 6 months.
