1. Littera Education Partnership with Ottawa Area ISD

- The Ottawa Area ISD recently signed a partnership agreement with Littera Education to help more students gain access to customized, high-impact tutoring supported by the Delta Math Rtl Program.
- Littera Education provides a tutoring management system, curriculum integrations, and virtual tutors for schools that may need any, or all of these services.
- Littera Education learned about the Delta Math Rtl Program while working with schools who were familiar with Delta Math. After exploring the resources and speaking to multiple schools currently using "Delta Math", Littera reached out to the OAISD to explore possibilities to provide Delta Math resources on their virtual tutoring platform.

2. New Implementation Video

- The Delta Math implementation video was 8 years old and no longer represented the latest recommendations for implementing a multi-tiered system of support for math. Therefore, the OAISD worked with MindSpring productions to make a few modifications.
- We hope you find the <u>new implementation video</u> useful for introducing the Delta Math Rtl Program to new staff members and parents.

3. Visual Fluency Support

- Visual fluency cards were inspired by Graham Fletcher's <u>Multiplication Subitizing Cards</u> and are available because of a partnership with the Berrien RESA. <u>Visual fluency cards and directions</u> for 7 different activities are available for free and can be printed from the Tier 2 and Tier 3 tabs at www.deltamath.org.
- Visual fluency cards help students strengthen and maintain basic fact fluency using 5-frame, 10-frame, and area models to reinforce the following fluency strategies: Add from the larger number, make a ten to add, think add to subtract, multiply by 5 and some more, and think multiply to divide.
- Visual fluency cards printed on cardstock, cut, sorted, and bundled are now available to save teachers and interventionists preparation time. Elementary and Secondary packages support up to 10 students and contain 5 decks of cards per readiness standard.
