Students Share Thinking

- Would someone like to share how they found the same, or different, answer?
- How about someone else?
- Let's look at the next question...(repeat the process for the remaining questions_

Student Reflection

- Now that thinking was shared with other students, I would like you to answer the following 2 questions...What did you remember and what did you learn today about the learning target?
- Who would like to share their thoughts first?
- Before we measure how close you are to meeting the learning goal, please show me with a thumbs up, down or side-ways how confident you feel about meeting the learning target on your own?
 (You may also use a scale from 1 to 5)
