

$4 \times 6 = 24$	$5 \times 3 = 15$
$7 \times 0 = 0$	$1 \times 8 = 8$
$8 \times 6 = 48$	$9 \times 6 = 36$
$2 \times 4 = 8$	$7 \times 3 = 21$
$9 \times 7 = 63$	$5 \times 9 = 35$
$5 \times 10 = 50$	$6 \times 2 = 12$
$8 \times 2 = 16$	$8 \times 4 = 32$
$3 \times 9 = 27$	$7 \times 7 = 49$

Question 17: When you are told to begin, answer as many as you can in 1 minute.

$30 \div 5 = 6$	$10 \div 2 = 5$
$6 \div 2 = 3$	$72 \div 9 = 8$
$40 \div 8 = 5$	$36 \div 4 = 9$
$12 \div 3 = 4$	$28 \div 7 = 4$
$54 \div 6 = 9$	$18 \div 6 = 3$
$28 \div 4 = 7$	$64 \div 8 = 8$
$24 \div 3 = 8$	$50 \div 10 = 5$
$42 \div 6 = 7$	$14 \div 7 = 2$
